Parents' Weekend is a special time dedicated to Aggie parents and family, and gives Aggie students a chance to express their gratitude to those who have impacted their lives.

#HowdyParents Parents' Weekend is a long standing tradition at Texas A&M. It began in 1919. when membership in the Corps of Cadets was mandatory. Mothers who worried about their sons formed the Aggie Mother's Club to help their sons get through the "fish" and underclassmen years. An open house program was started and held on Mother's Day, before graduation. In 1969, graduation was pushed up and the program was moved to April. Corps flower pinning, chapel services, military reviews, Parents of the Year receptions, campus tours and outfit award presentations have been part of the weekend since its beginning. New activities are continually being added to include a wider variety of students. Some of these new activities include a traditions program. concerts, Bevo Burn Barbecue, Maroon and White Football Game, All University Awards, and 'Ol Army Yell Practice.

together, eat a little, and live over the days you spent at the A&M College of Texas." April 21st is Aggie Muster. Aggie Muster is a time honored tradition at Texas A&M that is held all over the world, wherever Aggies can gather. It officially began on April 21, 1922 as a day for remembrance of fellow Aggies. The "Roll Call for the Absent" commemorates Aggies, former and current students, who died during the year. Aggies light candles while friends and families of Aggies who died that year answer "here" when the name of their loved one is "called". http://muster.tamu.edu/.

Denim Day April 22 Denim Day is an all day event where everyone is asked to wear jeans to challenge Sexual Violence and raise awareness. 'Ask Me Why I'm

Denim Day began as a response to the rape of an 18 year old Italian girl in 1992. The 45 year old driving instructor was convicted, however, an Italian appeals court overturned the conviction and the rapist went free. The reason was because the woman was wearing tight jeans and so would have had to help remove them, therefore, she consented.
